## POLICY:

As a member of the Board, a Director:

- Helps to implement decisions of the Board;
- Serves as an advocate for the board.

## **PROCEDURE:**

A Director:

- 1. Abides by the Constitution and Bylaws of the Galiano Library Society.
- 2. Governs the Library by the policies developed by the Board.
- 3. Recommends policy to the Policy and Planning Committee.
- 4. Stays current on issues of library governance including policy, finance and programs.
- 5. Prepares for and participates in the discussions and the deliberations of the Board.
- 6. Oversees committee work as assigned by the Board.
- 7. Attends monthly meetings of the Board of Directors and sends notice to the Chair if unable to attend.
- 8. Is aware of and abstains from any conflict of interest.

- 9. Serves a two year term and is eligible for re-election at the Annual General Meeting. The maximum number of directors is 15.
- 10. Does not receive remuneration but may be reimbursed for expenses.
